



- <u>Broward College</u> is part of a statewide consortium to under Florida TRADE to develop and deliver accelerated technical training programs which is funded by \$15 million US Department of Labor grant, to reduce training costs.
- Under Florida TRADE, OSHA 30 General Industry training is available at no cost a \$189 value. OSHA 30 General Industry training provides for the recognition, avoidance, abatement, and prevention of safety and health hazards in the workplace.
- The 100% fully narrated and interactive <u>OSHA 30 General Industry online training</u> developed by the University of South Florida and American Safety Council provides:
  - 30 hours of online training including 24 lessons, quizzes, and final exam.
    - To pass, must complete in 180 days and earn 70% on quizzes/final within three attempts.
  - Easy access, no special system requirements are needed.
    - All materials to successfully complete are in the online course and access is available to course trainer/customer and technical support.
    - Training participants have the option to purchase a book to supplement online course material at a cost of \$49.95. Florida TRADE does not cover the cost of the book
  - Completers earn:
    - Official OSHA 30 Card from Department of Labor
    - Official OSHA Training Education Certificate of Completion
- To be eligible for Florida TRADE training funds, each trainee must:
  - Enroll in Florida TRADE and provide the following support documentation:
    - Signed Florida TRADE Application and General Release
    - · Copy of Driver's License
    - Copy of Social Security Card
    - Evidence of US Citizenship, Permanent Resident Card, or other documentation confirming ability to work in US
    - Veterans please provide copy of DD214 form
