The purpose of this agreement is to acknowledge the transferability of all credits listed on the attached equivalency table.

Grades earned through Prior Learning Assessment by taking proficiency exams are eligible for transfer.

All courses must be completed with a "C" grade or better in order to transfer.

This agreement will expire two years from date of signing.

This agreement takes effect when all authorized signatures are affixed to this agreement, and it will expire two years from that date.
