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Drive	storing or accessing files on an external drive or how to connect a USB drive to the PC	basic skills such as connecting an external drive and launching File Explorer, but has difficulty in accessing the files	and manage files on an external drive but doesn't disconnect the device properly (safely remove)	and manage files on an external drive and safely ejects the drive before disconnecting the device	
Deleting Files	Able to delete files but doesn't understand that the files still exist and/or unaware to use the Recycle Bin	Deletes files and is aware that the files are not permanently removed, but unable to access the Recycle Bin	Deletes files and accesses the Recycle Bin, but unable to locate the specific file	Deletes files, restores files, and permanently removes files from the Recycle Bin	
Using Shortcuts	Unable to neither pin a file in File Explorer nor create a Desktop shortcut	Able to either pin a file or create a Desktop shortcut, but not both	Pins a file and creates a Desktop shortcut but unable to find it in File Explorer	Pins a file, creates a Desktop shortcut, and deletes the shortcut	
Zippping and Unzipping Files	Not familiar with either compressing files or identifying ZIP files in File Explorer	Locates and identifies the ZIP file but unable to extract its contents	Able to extract contents from a ZIP file but not able to compress files into a zipped folder	Able to both create a zip file and extract contents from an existing zip folder	





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
