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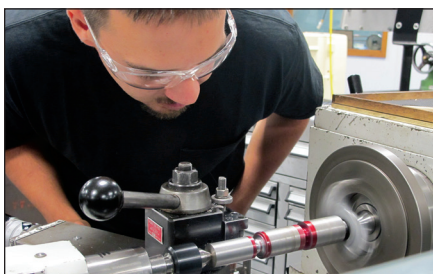

The four DEMT core courses are hybrid.

- Students will meet face-to-face at regularly scheduled times for about 50% of the class.
- ToolingU online skills training, requiring computer and Internet access, makeup the other 50% of the course.
- The four courses align with the nationally-recognized Manufacturing Skill Standards Council (MSSC) Certified Production Technician (CPT) credential. Each course prepares students to pass a specific MSSC certification test and qualify for the CPT credential in that area.
- Students may apply these introductory courses toward a Certificate, a Diploma, or an Associate of Applied Science degree.



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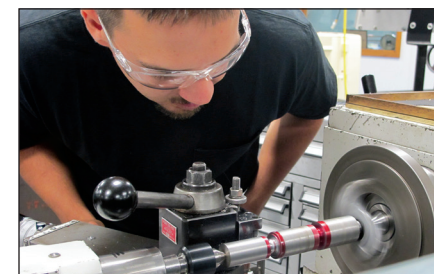
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
