Through a grant provided by the US Department of Labor, New England Institute of Technology established the Shipbuilding/Marine and Advanced Manufacturing Institute (SAMI) to build a pipeline of skilled workers for these industries. SAMI is located at the Center for Technologies Building at NEIT's Post Rd. Campus, 2480 Post Rd., Warwick, RI.

Applicants will have an opportunity to learn about the program, industries and careers, and to participate in hands-on skill evaluations to inform decision making about training and a career in the shipbuilding or manufacturing industries.
