AMT Program Participant ID Privileges

Applied Manufacturing Technology Certificate program participants are not responsible for paying any student activity fees associated with the AMT Tiger Card ID. Therefore, it can be used only in the following ways:

1. Serves as a campus identification card and should be carried with you at all times.
2. Can be used to gain access to the Julia Tutwiler Library, Guy Hunt Hall and Young Hall Cafeteria only.
3. Can be used to load funds to use for printing.

AMT Program Participant ID Limitations

1. Cannot be used in the UWA Wellness/Fitness Center.
2. Cannot be used to gain access to the UWA Swimming Pool.
3. Cannot be used to gain access to any campus activities or sporting events.
4. Cannot be used at the UWA Cinema.
5. AMT Tiger Card ID's do not contain any dining dollars or tiger bucks.

Use of Manufacturing Technology Tiger ID's other than allowable will cause termination of use of your Tiger Card and/or result in charges that you will be responsible for to the University.

Campus Facilities Restrictions

UWA AMT Program participants are only authorized to be in the following locations on the UWA Campus: Guy Hunt Hall & Hunt Annex (Houses Classrooms/Labs), Julia Tutwiler Library and Young Hall Cafeteria. At no point should you be in any Campus residence hall or other facilities on campus as an AMT participant. Your presence in any other location on campus will be as an off-campus guest and any disciplinary or behavior issues will be treated as such.
