
App Management

Here were going to group apps together according to our needs, and remove apps we no longer want or need. We'll start by removing unwanted unneeded apps. Start by pressing and holding the app until it starts to shake and has a small x I the top left corner. Just press the small x and your app will be removed. To group apps that you may use together press the app you want to combine until it starts to shake.

What is a secure password?

Tips for creating a strong password

Passwords provide the first line of defense against unauthorized access to your computer. The stronger your password, the more protected your computer will be from hackers and malicious software. You should make sure you have strong passwords for all accounts on your computer. If you're using a corporate network, your network administrator might require you to use a strong password.

What makes a password strong (or weak)?

A strong password:

- Is at least eight characters long.
- Does not contain your user name, real name, or company name.
- Does not contain a complete word.
- Is significantly different from previous passwords.
- Contains characters from each of the following four categories:

Character category	Examples
Uppercase letters	А, В, С
Lowercase letters	a, b, c
Numbers	0, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9
Symbols found on the keyboard (all keyboard characters not defined as letters	`~!@#\$%^&*()+={}[]\ :; '''<>,.?/

A password might meet all the criteria above and still be a weak password. For example, Hello2U! meets all the criteria for a strong password listed above, but is still weak because it contains a complete word. H3llO 2 U! is a stronger alternative because it replaces some of the letters in the complete word with numbers and also includes spaces.

Help yourself remember your strong password by following these tips:


- Create an acronym from an easy-to-remember piece of information.
- Substitute numbers, symbols, and misspellings for letters or words in an easy-to-remember phrase.
- Relate your password to a favorite hobby or sport. For example, I love to play badminton could becomelLuv2PlayB@dm1nt()n.

If you feel you must write down your password in order to remember it, make sure you don't label it as your password, and keep it in a safe place.

How to use secure passwords with your iPad.

Using a password or phassphrase is more secure than using a passcode. This is because your not limited to only 4 digits. Let's walk through this process of creating both below.





You will then be asked to enter your new passcode. This is where you put your secure password. You will be asked this twice after the second time your new secure password has been set.




