1. Synopsis of Findings:

Nursing Simulation Lab Manual – Would recommend having separate manuals (or at least clearly designated sections) for the Skills Lab and the Simulation Lab. New Nursing Ed rules define what constitutes simulation, also outlines criteria for needed policies. See attachment. More detail in notes.

2. Content Strengths:

Nursing Simulation Lab Manual- Comprehensive overview of lab facilities and equipment. Debriefing techniques are sound and referenced. Resources for faculty development are cited and from well known, trusted sources.

3. Areas for Improvement:

Nursing Simulation Lab Manual-Current rendition does not meet the criteria proposed in the new Nursing Ed Rules, specifically WAC 246-840-534 and 246-840-010. Labs/Sims exercises described under each course appear to be educationally sound. Do they all align with the course outcomes?

4. Other Observations:

Nursing Simulation Lab Manual- Manual references the INACSL standards. A Simulation Manual might be organized around these standards with each addressed specifically and consideration given to WAC 246-840-534.
