1. Synopsis of Findings:

Redesign Report – Some inaccuracies (see notes). Some typos/grammar errors (see notes). DEU model not implemented here in Bellingham as in Portland. Many statements do not cite supporting data. Simulation does not equal DEU, by definition DEU happens in a facility. What competencies were developed? How many more RNs are in the community? More detail in notes.

2. Content Strengths:

Redesign Report - Correct conclusion about the use of simulation decreasing demand for clinical space. Good justification for use of CBT and changing the curriculum. (See notes).

3. Areas for Improvement:

Redesign Report - Concept based teaching is about the theory side of the program, not the clinical. Clinical experiences were redesigned to focus on certain concepts from theory. There is no data presented to support the outcomes. The CCR, Simulation, and DEU do not seem to directly address the outcomes in Para #2 of the introduction. See more detail in notes.

4. Other Observations:

Redesign Report – There seems to be some confusion and overlap of the ideas. See notes for suggestions.
