**Official Articulation between
Vincennes University and Trine University**



Statement of Purpose

The purpose of this Articulation Agreement is to provide a framework and mechanism for a cooperative relationship between Trine University and Vincennes University to benefit students who desire to complete a bachelor's degree. The intent is for graduates of the Associate of Science in Supply Chain Logistics Management degree program at Vincennes University the ability to transition seamlessly into the Bachelor of Applied Management baccalaureate degree program at Trine University. Faculty and administrators of both universities have determined that the 60 semester credit hour associate degree program listed above meets the transfer requirements necessary for acceptance into the "2+2" transfer program leading to the Trine University Bachelor of Applied Management.

Transfer Agreement

2015 graduates and onward of Vincennes University, with an Associate of Science in Supply Chain Logistics Management, from any Vincennes University campus, may transfer and apply up to 60 credits from that completed degree to the requirements for a Trine University Bachelor of Applied Management.

Addendum One: Associate of Science Course Requirements for Transfer details the course requirements for this transfer agreement, including remaining courses required at Trine University (transfer institution) to fulfill the baccalaureate degree requirements.

Articulation Principles

1. Vincennes University (VU) students are eligible for admission with Junior standing to Trine University (TU) provided:
 - a. The student has earned an Associate of Science degree from VU.
 - b. The student has submitted a complete application for admission to Trine University.
 - c. A course grade of "C" or better must be earned to be accepted for transfer.
 - d. The student has a 2.0 or higher grade point average on a 4-point scale.
2. VU students transferring to TU's School of Professional Studies are eligible for a \$100 per credit hour tuition discount (Dean's Discount) provided:
 - a. The student has earned an Associate of Science degree from VU.
 - b. The student has a 3.0 or higher grade point average on a 4-point scale.
 - c. The student maintains a 3.0 or higher grade point average on a 4-point scale at TU.
3. As VU graduates complete the 120 credit hour requirement for the award of the Bachelor of Applied Management, they must meet the graduation requirements as approved by TU at the time of the student's admission to Trine University's program.
4. Written notice of intention to terminate, modify, or withdraw from this Articulation Agreement will be submitted by the academic head of either institution at least one academic semester prior to the proposed date of termination/withdrawal. Should a decision be made to modify or dissolve this agreement, students who are already attending Trine University at the time will be permitted to complete their degree as long as their academic performance remains in good standing.
5. Recognizing that changes in curricula and course content are inevitable, each institution agrees to discuss with the other institution all curriculum changes affecting this agreement before the changes are implemented.
6. A review of this agreement and the resulting programs will take place every three years by the representatives from both institutions.


Official Acknowledgements

The below parties, by their signature, agree to this above articulation on behalf of their respective University. They agree that they do have the authority to implement this agreement and plans of actions and or procedures necessary to affect this agreement. This agreement will be considered in force and valid when signed by both parties. The effective date will be that of which the last date is recorded with the final signature. The agreement will be effective until terminated by either party but only after a required 90 day window of notice for termination.


