<i>If your company has any of the following...</i>	<i>MAAC can help...</i>
Employees in entry-level jobs that would like to advance to a better paying position.	Consider the many award options at HTC that would lead to a better paying job.
Employees with manufacturing-related military experience.	Facilitate testing out of entry-level courses allowing employees to be placed further along in the curriculum, thereby shortening the time to earn an award.
Employees with on-the-job experience in manufacturing, but no college credit.	
Employees with a combination of different types of training or college credits, but not a complete degree or award.	If the combination of current credits does not fit within an existing award, they may work toward an A.S. degree in Individualized Studies.
Employees want to earn NIMS credentials.	Explore the coursework at HTC that would enable employees to become credentialed.
Employees want to earn PMMI credentials.	
Employees work full-time or will have limited release time preventing them from attending classes full-time.	Connect employees to curriculum allowing them to take a majority or all courses online.
	Provide access to a vLab with state-of-the-art simulators to practice skills or fulfill the hands-on requirements of a course.
Employees need specialized training due to new equipment or processes.	Facilitate instruction through Customized Training Services and make vLab equipment available on campus or at your company.
Interest in providing ongoing training on various topics relating to Welding, Automated Controls, or Machining on a regular basis	Facilitate the use of our vLab on a monthly, membership basis to utilize our cutting edge equipment and curriculum
