# ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

The Environmental Science Technology program at the OTC Waynesville Center and Richwood Valley Campus focuses on laboratory and field tests to monitor the environment and investigate sources of pollution and contamination, including those affecting public health. Students will utilize the hybrid program which includes both hands-on learning and online study to operate environmental testing equipment, conduct field tests, and monitor the environment.

## **Length of Program:**

*1 year* – 32 credit hour certificate

*2 year* – 62 credit hour associate of  
Applied Science Degree

## **How to enter the program:**

*Step 1:* Apply to OTC

*Step 2:* Apply for grant eligibility with a  
Missouri Career Center or OTC Advisor

*Step 3:* Complete grant and new student  
orientation with OTC Advisor

*Step 4:* Register for classes

tuition-waived courses.***
